Description	<p>The Settle Sofa invites you to settle into its comfort, providing an ideal setting for enjoying the outdoors all day. Its airy steel frame, complete with visible belts and intricate details, enhances its visual allure from all angles. Settle's steel frame is galvanized, primed, and powder-coated, ensuring corrosion resistance for long-lasting use. The plush cushions, made with quick-dry foam and durable outdoor textiles, offer fast-drying resilience in rain showers and year-round durability when used with an outdoor cover. The corner section expands the modular design, allowing sofa modules to connect seamlessly for more spacious and versatile outdoor lounge configurations.</p>
Material	<p>Back cushion: The back cushion consists of a single outdoor-suited foam core wrapped in wadding and enclosed in an inner lining. It is finished with outdoor-suited upholstery. Loose cushions for added back support can be purchased separately.</p> <p>Seat cushion: The seat cushion is constructed from multiple layers of outdoor-suited foam to provide enhanced support and comfort. The foam is wrapped in wadding and an inner lining, and finished with outdoor-suited upholstery. An integrated anti-slip feature helps keep the cushion securely in place.</p> <p>Frame and webbing: The frame is made from bent steel tubes and rods that are electro-galvanized, primed, and powder-coated. The webbing is made from 71% polypropylene (PP) and 29% natural rubber.</p> <p>Please note that the Corner Section should only be used linked together with other Settle Sofa modules. Two sets of linking brackets are included.</p> <p>The product is designed for disassembly of the main components (frame, armrests, cushions, covers, webbing, glides) to enable repair, refurbishment, and/or recycling.</p>

Cleaning & Care

Textile – General Maintenance: For stains, non-greasy marks should be gently dabbed with a lint-free cloth or sponge wrung out in clean, warm water. If needed, a mild solution of dish soap and water may be used, followed by dabbing with clean water.

Textile – Stain treatment: Stains should be treated promptly, as older stains are more difficult to remove. Professional furniture cleaning is recommended for set-in stains. Any treatment method should be tested on a concealed area before use. Several light applications are recommended rather than one concentrated treatment, and the process may be repeated if necessary. Heat should never be applied, as it may set the stain, and bleach-containing products should be avoided, as they can cause discoloration. The fabric should not be over-saturated, and water should not be allowed to pool in the seams. Excess moisture should be absorbed immediately.

For oil- or water-based stains, a clean, soft white cloth, natural sponge, or nylon soft-bristle brush should be used with a water-free dry-cleaning solvent. Brushing should be carried out with light, quick strokes from the outer edge toward the center, taking care not to scrub.

For insoluble stains—such as chewing gum or candle wax—a plastic bag filled with ice should be applied until the material becomes brittle, then carefully lifted with a clean, dull, flat knife.

Extra care should be taken with dark textiles to avoid visible light marks from color transfer. Excessive rubbing should be avoided, and the textile should be allowed to dry thoroughly before vacuuming or reuse.

Powder-coated surfaces: The surface should be cleaned with a cloth dampened with water. If needed, a mild detergent or dish soap can be used. Concentrated and abrasive cleaning agents should be avoided, as these may damage the finish. Any liquids, grease, or residues should be removed immediately to reduce the risk of stains and marks. Surfaces should always be wiped dry with a clean cloth afterward. In line with ECDC guidelines, powder-coated surfaces can tolerate regular disinfection using 70% ethanol. Care should be taken to avoid impacts from hard objects, as lacquered surfaces may scratch or chip.

Covers: A protective cover is recommended to shield the furniture from prolonged weather exposure, particularly during the winter months. Before the cover is applied, it must be ensured that both the furniture and the interior of the cover are completely dry. For extended periods of storage, cushions should be stored indoors in a dry, well-ventilated area. Proper ventilation is essential to prevent moisture build-up and the formation of mould.
