KLAMPENBORG TABLE LAMP
Designed by *Mogens Lassen*

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Mogens Lassen designed the Klampenborg Table Lamp in 1944, but the eye-catching design was first put into production in 2022 after being rediscovered in the Lassen archives at the Danish National Art Library in Copenhagen where it was merely a sketch on a yellowing sheet of paper.

An illuminating vision of the Danish designer's take on architecture and life, the lamp adds function and character to everyday settings and activities. Sculptural and striking in its expression, its curved metal frame holds two divergent shades — one to reflect the light upwards; the other to direct it downwards — filling a space with soft and ambient light. Shaping the atmosphere of a room, a three-step dimmer adjusts the intensity. Beautiful from all angles and crafted in a quality that lasts, the Klampenborg lamp is available in matt black powder-coated steel, polished steel and brushed brass.

About the designer

Considered one of Denmark's greatest and most influential architects, Mogens Lassen (1901–1987) pioneered Danish Functionalism, taking his cues from Bauhaus sensibilities. His interior designs are a natural continuation of his architectural approach and add energy and atmosphere to everyday living spaces and tasks. From decorative objects to larger furniture designs, each delicately balances presence with practicality, and without drawing undue attention to find its natural place in any space.
