More than sixty years since it was first created, the Kubus Collection remains at the forefront of covetable Danish design. Striking yet simple in its expression, the first of the Kubus candle holders was designed in 1962 for a small restaurant in northern Denmark. Reserved primarily for his family, friends and colleagues, Lassen soon realised the widespread appeal of his functionalist piece and put it into wider production before expanding the series with new designs.

Experimenting with new forms and functions, Lassen based the Kubus Collection on a strict mathematical formula and Bauhaus ideals. A perfectionist by nature, nothing was left to chance. The result is a harmonious and slender geometric steel frame, perfectly proportioned and challenging the material while satisfying the senses.

From the first design to tealight and hurricane iterations, as well as bowls, flowerpots, vases that double as storage solutions, a bottom plate to prevent drips and damage to surfaces, and a candle snuffer and matchbox, Kubus continues to evolve in step with modern needs.

About the designer

Considered one of Denmark's greatest and most influential architects, Mogens Lassen (1901–1987) pioneered Danish Functionalism, taking his cues from Bauhaus sensibilities. His interior designs are a natural continuation of his architectural approach and add energy and atmosphere to everyday living spaces and tasks. From decorative objects to larger furniture designs, each delicately balances presence with practicality, and without drawing undue attention to find its natural place in any space.
