Kaare Klint's KK43960 Mix Chair has earned iconic status among collectors since its unveiling in 1931. This chair is admired for its elegant, flowing form and its intricate construction concept.

## DESIGNER

One of the most revered founding fathers of Danish furniture design, Kaare Klint (1888–1954), influenced several generations of Danish furniture designers with his mathematically-based functionalism. He exerted his influence as a visionary educator through several distinctive furniture works that collectively became the paragon of functionalist design.

Klint's greatest strengths were his unique sense of proportion and spatial awareness. He firmly believed furniture should suit and conform to its user and based his classic designs on the careful study of the human body, originating the concept of 'human furniture'.
